RESOLUTION NO.: 2023 – 08

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JASPER, ALABAMA

WHEREAS, Rural King Realty, Inc. proposes to located within the City of Jasper, Alabama, a retail sales facility at the Jasper Mall property within the City of Jasper; and

WHEREAS, Rural King Realty, Inc., proposes a major renovation of the said facility, which expansion and renovation shall result in new employment opportunities for citizens of the City of Jasper and the surrounding area, the utilization of underutilized property within the City, the infill of vacant and potentially blighted property within the City, and other economic benefits for the citizens of the City of Jasper, Alabama; and

WHEREAS, Rural King Realty, Inc., has applied to the City Council of the City of Jasper, Alabama, for economic development assistance with the project, including, specifically, a cash payment and a rebate of a portion of future sales taxes generated by retail activities on the property; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Jasper, Alabama, has conducted a hearing at a regularly scheduled City Council meeting, and has determined that the proposed assistance is a valid public purpose and is in the best interests of the citizens of the City of Jasper;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Jasper, Alabama, as follows:

- 1). That the City Council of the City of Jasper, Alabama, does approve of the proposed cash payment and abatement of a portion of future sales taxes generated by retail activities on the property;
- 2). That the City Council of the City of Jasper, Alabama, does approve and ratify the Economic Development Agreement between the City of Jasper and Rural King Realty, Inc.; and
- 3). That Mayor David P. O'Mary is authorized to act on behalf of the City of Jasper, Alabama, and execute the Economic Development Agreement with Rural King Realty, Inc., for the payment and for the abatement of a portion of future sales taxes generated from retail activities on the property.

ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JASPER, ALABAMA

Ordinance No. 2023 - 01

To Amend the Ordinance Designating Truck Routes Within the City of Jasper, Alabama

WHEREAS, the City of Jasper, Alabama, has designated certain roadways within the City of Jasper, Alabama, as "truck routes", being those roads on which commercial vehicles are permitted to travel; and

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the City Council of the City of Jasper, Alabama, that 14th Avenue NE from 2nd Street NE to Pineview Road is not an acceptable "truck route" within the City of Jasper;

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Jasper, Alabama, as follows:

Section 1. To the extent that 14th Avenue NE from 2nd Street NE to Pineview Road has been designated a "truck route", the same is revoked, amended, and reversed, and 14th Avenue NE from 2nd Street NE to Pineview Road shall not be a "truck route" within the City of Jasper, Alabama.

Section 2. The provisions of this Ordinance are severable, such that if any portion of the Ordinance is ruled invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining portions of said Ordinance shall be unaffected thereby.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval in the manner required by the laws of the State of Alabama.
