# PROCLAMATION

Office of the Mayor of Jasper, Alabama

WHEREAS trees are a renewable resource giving us paper, wood for our homes, fuel for our fires, and countless other wood products; and

WHEREAS trees in our city increase property values, enhance the economic vitality of business areas, and beautify our community; and


WHEREAS trees - wherever they are planted - are a source of joy and spiritual renewal; and
